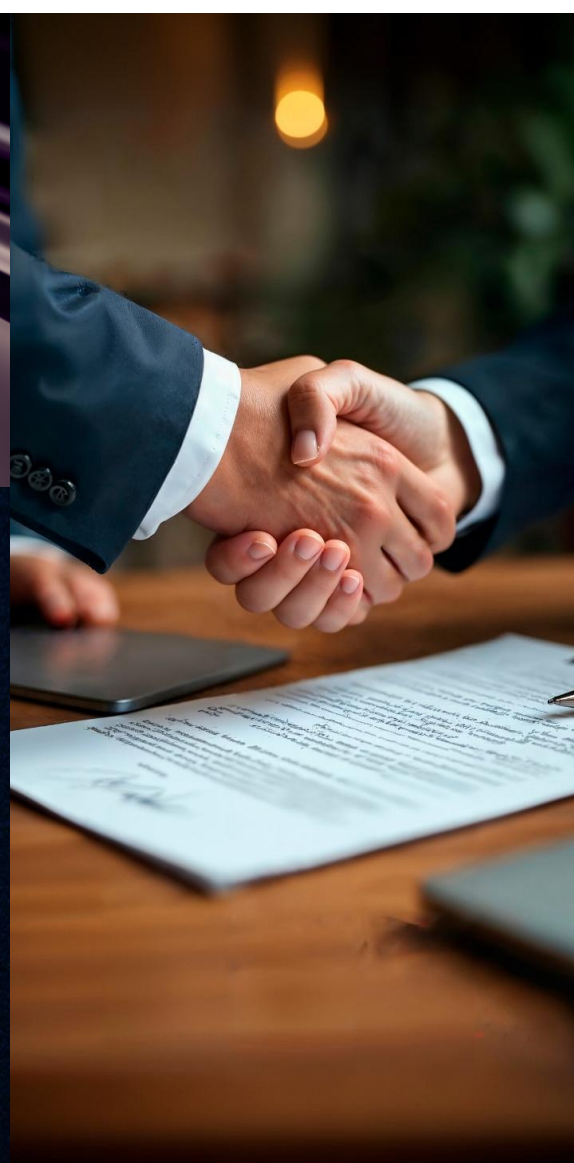

## 1<sup>st</sup> in Bharat Healthcare



### 1. First COVID-19 Vaccine Developed and Mass-Produced

- Covaxin: Bharat's first indigenous COVID-19 vaccine, developed by Bharat Biotech in collaboration with the Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR), was approved for emergency use in January 2021. It marked a significant milestone as India became one of the few countries to develop its own vaccine during the pandemic.
- Serum Institute of India (SII): While not the developer, SII became the world's largest producer of the Oxford-AstraZeneca vaccine (branded as Covishield in India), rolling out millions of doses globally, making India a key player in the global vaccination effort.

### 2. First Heart Transplant in Bharat

- Performed on August 3, 1994, by Dr. P. Venugopal at the All Bharat Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS), New Delhi. This was a pioneering moment in Indian cardiac surgery, showcasing the country's advancing medical expertise.

### 3. First Robotic Surgery

- In 1998, the Escorts Heart Institute in New Delhi conducted Bharat's first robotic heart surgery, introducing cutting-edge technology to Indian healthcare.
- First Successful Liver Transplant
- Conducted in 1998 by Dr. A.S. Soin at Apollo Hospital, New Delhi. This marked the beginning of advanced organ transplantation in India.



# Largest in the World Achievements in **Bharat** Healthcare



## **1. COVID-19 Vaccine Production**

- Serum Institute of India (SII): Recognized as the world's largest vaccine manufacturer by volume, SII produced over 1.5 billion doses of Covishield by mid-2022, supplying not only India but also numerous countries through the COVAX initiative. India's vaccination drive, launched on January 16, 2021, became one of the largest in the world, administering over 2.2 billion doses by early 2025.

## **2. Aravind Eye Hospital - Largest Eye Care Provider in the World**

- Founded in 1976 by Dr. Govindappa Venkataswamy in Madurai, Tamil Nadu, Aravind Eye Hospital has grown into the largest eye care system in the world by volume of surgeries and patient care. As of 2025, Aravind has treated over 85 million patients and performed more than 9.5 million eye surgeries, primarily focusing on cataracts.
- Largest Single-Day Vaccination Drive
- On September 17, 2021, India vaccinated over 25 million people in a single day, a world record, as part of its COVID-19 vaccination campaign. This feat highlighted India's capacity for mass healthcare delivery.

## **3. Bharat's Role in Global Health:**

- Bharat is often called the "pharmacy of the world" due to its massive production of generic drugs and vaccines. During the COVID-19 pandemic, it supplied over 60% of the world's vaccine demand.

## **4. Aravind's Global Impact:**

- Beyond its size, Aravind's model of cross-subsidization—where paying patients fund free or subsidized care for the poor—has been replicated worldwide, cementing its status as a leader in innovative healthcare delivery.

These achievements reflect Bharat's ability to combine innovation, scale, and affordability, positioning it as a global leader in healthcare despite challenges like population size and resource constraints

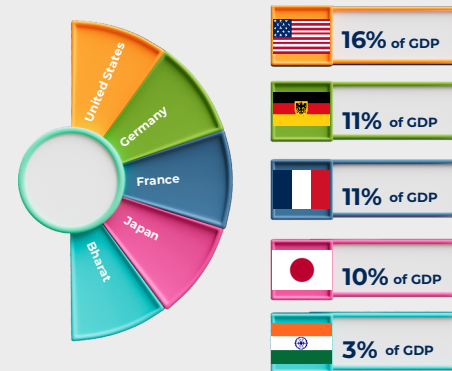


# Bharat's Healthcare Facts



## Global Healthcare Expenditure as a Percentage of GDP

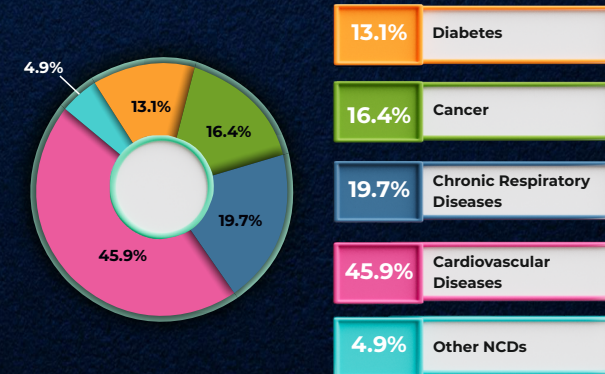
Different countries allocate their GDP to healthcare

## Impact of Non-Communicable Diseases (NCDs) in Bharat

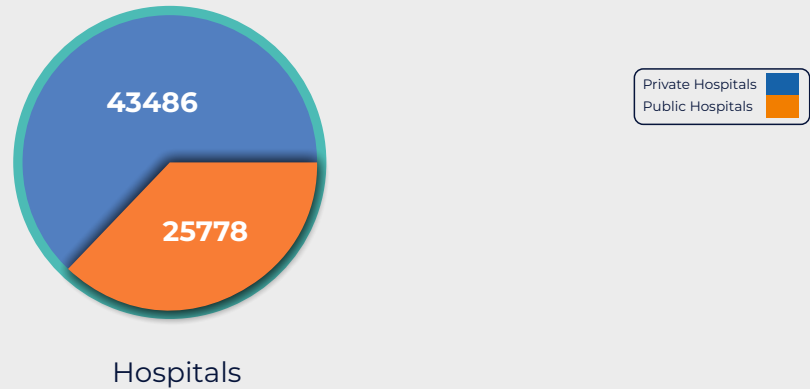

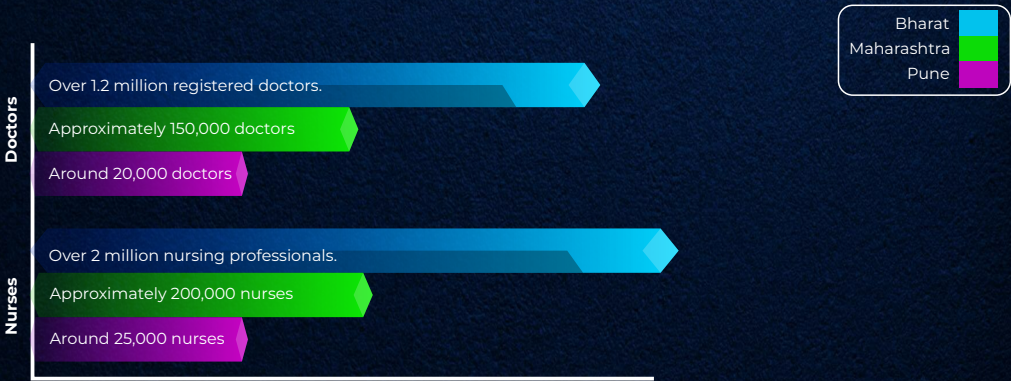
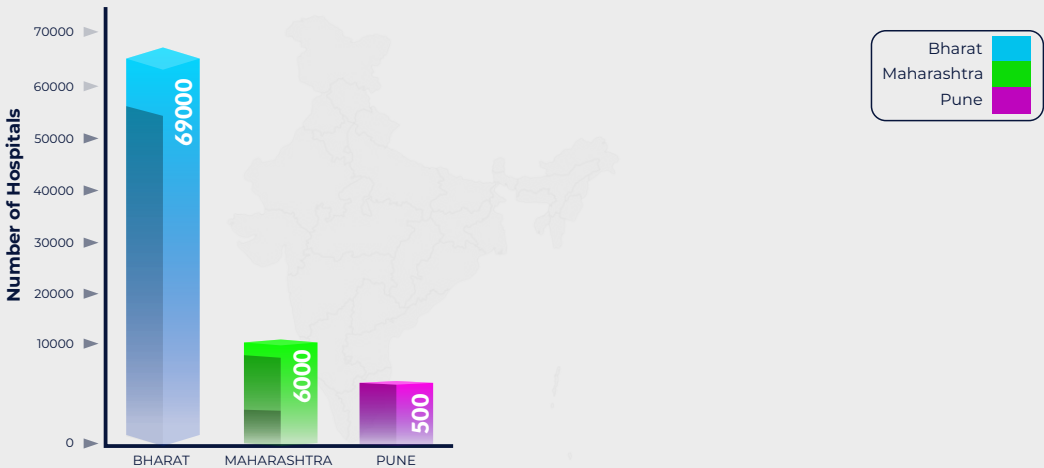
Healthcare infrastructure and doctor-to-population ratios in Bharat, Maharashtra, and Pune:

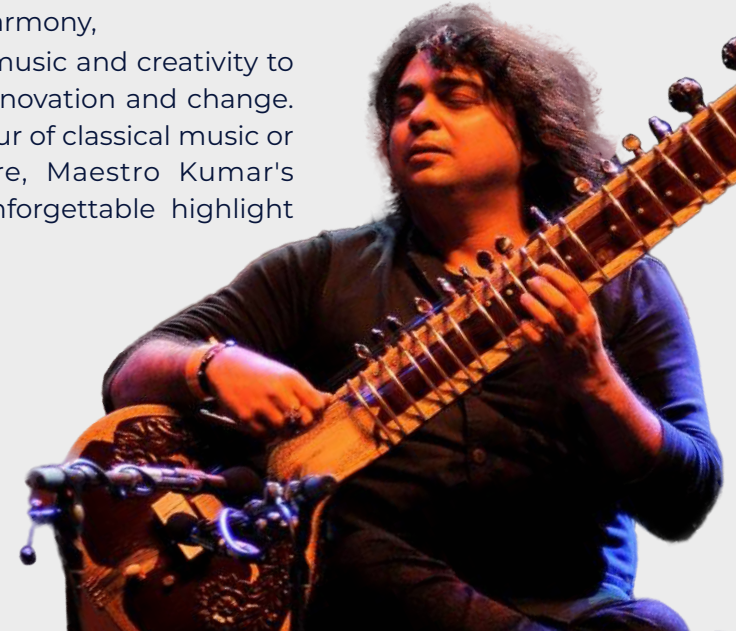

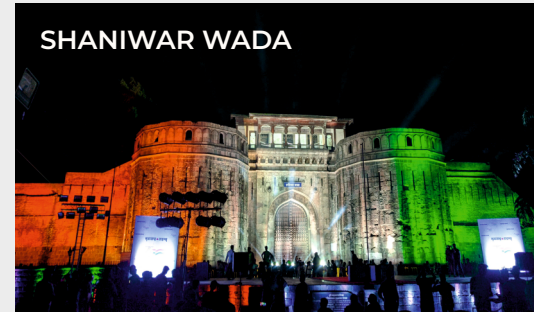

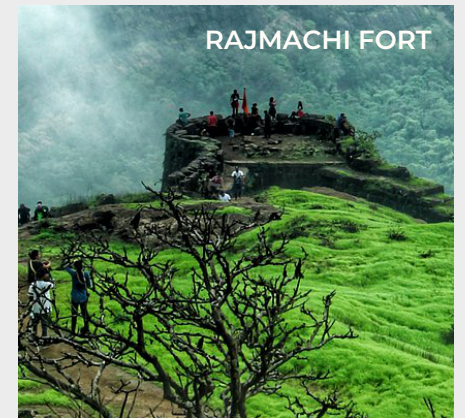
